Dear Mr Hariades,

Further to our meeting on Tuesday 11th October, I have appraised my fellow Directors of your Council's proposals as outlined by Kate Gason and yourself.

It is the Board's view that what is now proposed is so far removed from your earlier position as outlined in your draft Heads of Agreement as to be wholly unacceptable.

Unless the Council reverts to a position whereby it acquires and makes available the land necessary for the railway to extend to Egloskerry, as originally agreed and in line with the above mentioned document, this letter should be regarded as formal notice of our withdrawal from the TRAC project, and as a retraction of any offers or consents made by us.

Permission to carry out any surveying or other works on any railway land or watercourses owned by the Spice Settlement Trust is hereby revoked, and any proposals to bridge such land will be opposed.
